Dear Friends:

As one part of our process to be ONE FAMILY UNDER GOD, we are making some slight changes to our children's Religious Education program. This coming academic year we will offer both English classes and Spanish classes at the same time, on the same day, and in the same general space. We will offer Religious Education classes for all the children, regardless of what language they speak, on Saturday mornings and Monday evenings. We will attempt to have the groups evenly divided.

We are also going to add the Nazareth Program, only for the First Communion students, during the 1:30 p.m. Mass. This will offer another Religious Education opportunity for the Spanish speaking students. Nazareth is a combination Bible Study and Religious Education program. We already offer it at the 9:30 a.m. and 11:30 a.m. Masses.

Preparation for First Reconciliation and First Communion will be the same as before. Students will need to be enrolled in one of these three Religious Education Classes:

Monday evening
OR
Saturday morning
OR
Sunday Nazareth

PLUS attend the sacrament preparation classes. The Sacrament preparation classes will continue to be held on Wednesday evenings beginning in January. They will be offered in both languages. Spanish classes will be held in Nevin Hall and English classes in the Great Room. This keeps the church's profound respect for the role of parents in the sacramental preparation of their children. Registration for all classes will begin after all the Masses the weekend of August 27 and 28.

This is one way we are building our ONE FAMILY UNDER GOD. The children will lead us!

Anointing Service

Tuesday, August 23

"The Church believes and confesses that among the seven sacraments there is one especially intended to strengthen those who are being tried by illness, the **Anointing of the Sick**.

This sacred anointing of the sick was instituted by Christ our Lord as a true and proper sacrament of the New Testament. It is alluded to indeed in Mark, but is recommended to the faithful and promulgated by James the apostle and brother of the Lord (Catechism of the Catholic Faith, #1511)."

The Church remembers the custom of the early Church, recorded in the letter of James (5:14-16) that those in the Christian community who are ill should approach the elders (priests) of the Church and request praying over them. Therefore, we invite those among us who are seriously ill and who desire to participate in this sacrament to join us on Tuesday, August 23, either at 8:45 a.m. or 7:00 p.m. in the church.

21er Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Tenemos tres palabras muy importantes en las que debemos de reflexionar en el Evangelio de hoy: Iglesia, Pedro, y el Papa. La Iglesia, por vocación de nuestro bautismo, nos da derecho a ser seguidores de Jesús y a tomar responsabilidad de nuestro llamado a evangelizar, ejerciendo así nuestro compromiso al discipulado.
