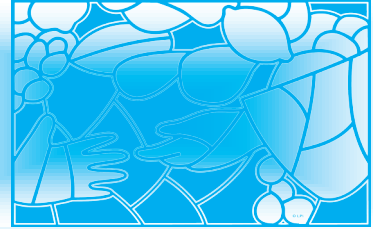

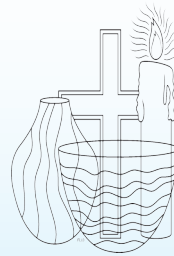

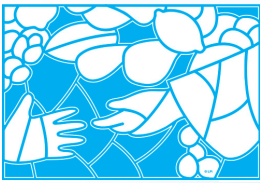

Pero luego al aceptar la invitación nos viene la preocupación por el vestido o traje que vamos a usar en la fiesta. Si por casualidad has tenido la experiencia de asistir a una fiesta sin un traje adecuado, me imagino que solamente recordarás lo mal que te sentías por estar fuera de tono de los demás invitados. ¿Recuerdas alguna experiencia similar? Me imagino que más de alguno habrá pensado en salir inmediatamente de la fiesta.

En los tiempos bíblicos, cuando los antiguos Israelitas trataban de imaginar cómo sería el reino de Dios, una de sus ideas favoritas era la de un banquete. Lo podemos escuchar hoy en el pasaje del profeta Isaías y en el Evangelio. San Mateo nos describe como el rey es que invita al banquete de bodas de su hijo. Pero llama la atención en este pasaje que los primeros invitados deciden no asistir: ni siquiera se toman la molestia de dar una excusa. Todos sabemos que esta parábola concierne al Reino de los cielos. ¿Pero qué tiene que ver esto con nosotros actualmente?

La parábola pues nos describe el banquete de la Eucaristía y de cómo lo celebramos. Éste es el banquete del Hijo de Dios, el cual nos dirige hacia el cumplimiento del Reino de Dios. ¿Cómo es nuestra participación en la Eucaristía? ¿Tenemos puesto el vestido de fiesta? La Eucaristía es nuestra identidad de cristianos. No lo olvidemos.
